Played at various venues in the West of Scotland, in 1927 the Edward family asked Glasgow Golf Club if they would host it annually at Gailes Links in Ayrshire.

The Club agreed and the Edward Trophy has been played there since 1928 and continues to attract a top home and international field.

The field will consist of 72 players. In the event of being oversubscribed the Club reserves the right to reduce the number by ballot based on Handicap Index.
